Bankruptcy (Scotland) Act 2016

The Bankruptcy (Scotland) Bill, prepared by the Commission, was passed by the Scottish Parliament on 22 March and received Royal Assent on 28 April 2016. The Act consolidates the Bankruptcy (Scotland) Act 1985 and subsequent legislation on bankruptcy. Read more...

The Succession (Scotland) Bill was passed by the Scottish Parliament on 28 January 2016 and received Royal Assent on 3 March 2016. It was the second Bill to be considered by the Delegated Powers and Law Reform Committee under a new procedure for certain Commission Bills.
