Dear Sirs,

I welcome the suggested changes to the Scottish Defamation laws. However, the following should be taken into account:

- The public interest defence is weaker than in the Defamation Act 2013. This must be more robust.
- Corporations would still have the right to sue. Corporations also have other means to defend themselves, such as malicious falsehood and laws governing advertising, competition and business practices they do not need protection under defamation law.
